#### **Easy to deploy**

A proven combination of tried and tested hardware, software, Internet now kiosks do not require setting up by trained technicians - just plug in the power cord and a phone line/ADSL/Network connection and the kiosk is operational.

Internet now kiosks are continually monitored from a central operation centre. So operations always have the latest status information at their fingertips. Alerts are generated when human intervention is required (e.g. cashbox full) ensuring an uninterrupted revenue stream from the kiosk.

##### **Who needs Internet now?**

Internet now is designed for independent kiosk operators, who don't wish to invest in the full technical infrastructure required to build, deploy and manage a network of kiosks.

##### **How is access charged for?**

An Internet now kiosk charges on a set rate per half hour, which can be set by the operator.

##### **Is it really 'plug and play'?**

Every computer needs some specific configurations before being connected to the Internet. Internet now kiosks are factory configured prior to shipping to known locations (with known connection characteristics). Upon arrival, all that needs to be added are a functioning power supply and telecomms connection.

Internet now kiosk installed and ready to use costs, as little as \$3,640 plus GST plus freight.

This cost includes three years 'back to base' warranty on all parts but excludes any service requirements.
